The vision is about Living Life Well and Living Life your Way in Dundee



In April and May 2022 the Health and Social Care Partnership and Advocating Together are asking what you think about the Vision.

The Vision says....



1. Everyone will get help to live well.

This means that you will have support from people who will help you when day to day living is difficult; this might include going to the shops: budgeting; advice if you are worried; help to wash and dress; clean house and laundry: Health care and support to live your life the way you want.

The help can be from friends, family, volunteers of staff.



2. Everyone will have good places to live in.

This means that you will have a choice of where you live and a choice about who you live with. You will have a warm house and comfortable furniture.



3. People will be able to use local shops in friendly communities.

This means that there will be affordable shops, that sell healthy foods. There will be beautiful public spaces, people will feel safe and welcome when they are in their local area.



4. Everyone will be friendly. Everyone will look after each other.

This means that we will try to be respectful to each other, and fair. We want everyone to be safe. We know Human Rights are important and sometimes it will be difficult to do this.



5. Everyone will have good relationships.

This includes relationships with friends, with family and romantic relationships.



6. Everyone will be able to have a social life.
