Provision of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in Dundee

Following guidelines issued by the Scottish Government on Thursday 23rd April, 2020, PPE for social care providers will be supplied through the West District Housing Office Hub. This will be for Social Care providers, Care Homes, Personal Assistants and Unpaid Carers, this will also include those in the community employed through a private arrangement. PPE supplied will include FRSM masks, gloves, eye protection and aprons.

For Care Homes and Social Care Providers:

You should continue to try to source and order your own PPE stock, however we appreciate this is increasingly difficult to do and where there are insufficient levels of PPE available you can request stock from the Dundee Hub at West District Housing Office (WDHO) by completing the attached PPE Request Form (V4) identifying the specific equipment required and emailing it to the WDHO Support Team wdhosupportteam@dundeecity.gov.uk. This email account is monitored between the hours of 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday.

- Please ensure your six digit unique code is noted on the order form, if your form is incomplete this will be sent back to you for revision.
- If you have more than one six digit code you will need to complete a form separately for each respective code related service.
- You will be contacted by email to inform you of your stock allocation and a collection time, a
 collection time is advised to ensure your safety and the safety of our staff while observing
 social distancing.
- If the PPE stock allocated is less than your order, this will be due to insufficient stock levels at
 the HUB. You will need to contact the NHS NSS Triage on 0300 303 3020 and order the
 difference in stock. We understand that this will be delivered to you directly the next day by
 mail or courier.
- Please ensure you bring with you ID and your six digit unique code.

For Personal Assistants (PA)

The Scottish Government guidance states that Personal Assistants are to contact the **NHS NSS Triage Support Centre** on <u>0300 303 3020</u>, they will complete a simple triage. They will email your details to the local Dundee HUB for processing.

- You will be contacted by email to discuss your order details and a collection time, a
 collection time is advised to ensure your safety and the safety of our staff while observing
 social distancing.
- If the PPE stock allocated is less than your order, this will be due to insufficient stock levels at the HUB. You will need to contact the **NHS NSS Triage on 0300 303 3020** and order the difference in stock. We understand that this will be delivered to you directly the next day by mail or courier (this will be an unlikely scenario as the NHS NSS HUB have access to Dundee's stock take system and will be able to assess the stock situation)
- You will need to bring a keyworker document with you for collection, if you do not have one you will need to ask your employer to contact Dundee Carers Centre who will issue your employer with the keyworker letter for distribution.

If you are unsatisfied with your response from the NHS NSS HUB and have self-assessed as requiring PPE, you can contact the Carer's Centre who will process assess the situation and forward a request to the Dundee HUB.
